#### **History Walk - Daniel Burnham and the Ocean** Shore Railroad

Learn about the early history of the area, the exciting arrival of the Ocean Shore Railroad and it development plans, and

the changes after the railroad disappeared. The walk covers about a mile and a half, with views of the harbor, two early train stations, remnants of the original curbs, and a number of early houses. 
# Other Useful Community Information
